Fee Scale

We understand that dancing can be an expensive activity, and we aim to do everything we can to minimise the costs involved. Affordability is important to us. Parents are able to choose how many classes per week that they would like their child to participate in, offering them control over costs. We offer concession card and family discounts, in addition to accepting 'Ticket to Play' vouchers.

What age can my child start classes?

We accept students from the age of 2 years into our Ready Set Dance program. From 5 years of age students can study jazz, tap and ballet. Lyrical, hip-hop and TapJam classes are available for older students. We also offer casual adult classes throughout the year.

Throughout the year we may offer recreational classes for adults in a variety of dance styles.

Is there a Uniform?

If it is a student's first class, they are not expected to wear uniform and can wear something that they can move in easily. If prospective students do not have a leotard and skirt or bike shorts, they can wear leggings, a t-shirt and bare feet.

We highly encourage all our students to wear correct uniform and footwear for all classes. Uniforms are an extremely important component of being a dancer as they:

- Encourage discipline and respect
- Encourage teachers to easily identify and correct alignment
- Promote unity within a class
- Encourage positivity and teamwork
- Help to build confidence
- Most importantly, we believe uniforms give our students a sense of belonging within our Encore community.

Am I allowed to view my child's class?

We have screens in both studio waiting areas which allow parents to view the classes.

Can I enrol during a term?

Students are welcome to enrol part way through a term if space is available, however we do cut off enrolments in term 3 due to concert preparations.

Do you offer assessments?

Students are able to participate in either Australian Dance Vision (ADV) Tap Assessments and/or Australian Teachers of Dancing (ATOD) Ballet and Jazz Assessments. Assessments are not compulsory.

Is there an annual concert?

We run a Mini and Senior concert for all students

Do you offer a Mentor Program?

Yes, we have the Encore Mentor Program. Encore is a recognised "DanceStep Dance Studio" – a formalised and progressive Dance Student Teacher Education Program which empowers students to serve as role models, grow as leaders and care for others in their dance studio community. Our Student Teacher and Leadership program provides learning opportunities for dance students from 11 years of age. Designed to develop leadership and valuable 'soft skills' (also referred to as employability skills) such as communication, teamwork, problem solving and emotional judgement.
