THE LOWDOWN



READY SET DANCE is a fun combo class of JAZZ, TAP, HIP HOP, SINGING, and MUSIC.

Designed for both boys and girls, the program focuses on teaching the fundamentals of dance while developing confidence, coordination and creativity in a professional and safe environment.

JAZZ

Develop muscle strength, control and balance and achieve coordination milestones like skipping before going to school.

FAQ

CAN I WATCH MY CHILD'S CLASSES?

In our experience, preschoolers are able to concentrate better without the distraction of other noise in the room from parents and siblings. Our program has been endorsed by leading child care experts who support the independent learning model. As preschoolers participate in classes they have the opportunity to develop additional secure attachments with adults (teachers) and peers. This helps them transition positively into the larger world and helps with school readiness.

Having said that, a lot of children are timid at first and need to know that a parent is close by. Our program allows parents to watch the first class if necessary to help them adjust.

ARE YOUR TEACHER'S QUALIFIED?

All teachers have their WWVP card and follow the program that is endorsed by early learning experts. READY SET DANCE teachers are required to gain their certification from READY SET DANCE head office before delivering the program.

DO WE NEED TO PURCHASE UNIFORM AND SHOES?

Students must wear the READY SET DANCE uniform. However, we need to make sure we are the right fit for you and your child before committing to anything. Comfortable clothes and sneakers are fine for the first couple of lessons. Once your child has settled you can purchase the official READY SET DANCE uniform at reception, which we are sure you will love.

IS THERE AN ANNUAL CONCERT?

We run a Mini Concert for all READY SET DANCE and other younger dancers at the end of each year. Participation in the show is, of course, optional. If you would like more information about our Mini Concert please contact us!

IF WE MISS A CLASS CAN IT BE MADE UP ON ANOTHER DAY OF THE WEEK?

You may swap days during Terms 1, 2 and 3 if you miss a class (as long as the make up class is not full). In term 4, each class works on a different routine for the end-of-year concert, and it is too confusing for students to be swapping days. We do recommend that you avoid alternating days too much as preschoolers need the comfort of knowing that the same teacher and their friends will be there when they go to dancing.

HOW CAN I EXPERIENCE READY SET DANCE AT HOME?

Ready Set Dance airs on Nick Jr and Paramount Plus. You can also catch us on YouTube and the Nick Jr Play App. The Show has been so popular that it is now airing in 120 countries all over the world. Preschoolers love to dance along to their favourite songs from the TV show in their classes every week.

CHILD SAFETY

At Encore Dance, every child and young person has the right to be safe and feel safe.

We are committed to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of every child and young person in our studio. Please see our Website for our full Commitment to Child along and Child Safety policies.

INVOICES

Fees are charged on a term basis. Invoices are sent at the beginning of each term.

PAYMENTS

Your invoice will have directions of how to pay your fees. Our preferred method of payment of GoCardless Direct Debit; this can be arranged upon enrolment/re-enrolment when first invoices are sent.

CREDITS AND REFUNDS

We do not offer credits or refunds for change of mind. If a class is missed, we do offer a make-up class (however this is subject to class availability and must be within the term).

FEES IN ARREARS

If you happen to fall behind in your fees, please reach out to our admin staff to arrange a payment plan.

CO-PARENTING

We can not split accounts. 1 invoice will be generated per student.

STUDENTS WHO ENROL MID-TERM

Students that enrol mid-term will be invoiced from date of enrolment through to the remainder of the term.

Instructions for GoCardless will be attached to your invoice. Please contact our admin staff if you have any questions or concerns regarding our direct debit service

CLASS ETIQUETTE

Our classrooms embody our school values. We foster a safe, positive, and inclusive environment for all dancers. We kindly request that our students and teachers are not disturbed during class, except in case of an emergency.

STUDIO & FEE POLICIES

ATTENDANCE

There are no refunds or discounts for classes missed during the term. If a class is missed, we can offer a make-up class (however this is subject to class availability). Make-up classes are only permitted within the term that they are missed. Should a dance class be cancelled during the term, we will offer a make-up class to the students involved or provide a credit of the single class price. If you know ahead of time that your child will be absent due to holidays/vacations, commitments or school trips, please let us know ahead of time.

HEALTH OF STUDENTS

In order to ensure the well-being of everyone, children with infectious illnesses such as Gastro must stay home until they are well enough to return. (48 hours after symptoms have ceased) As a general rule children should also not attend if they have an illness that prevents them from comfortably participating in class. If your child has ongoing medical needs, such as asthma or anaphylaxis, please inform us upon enrolment so that we can provide the best support for their needs.

DROP OFF/PICK UP

We ask you to stay with your child until they are in the classroom and ensure they are collected and dropped off on time. In the event of an emergency or delay, please contact the studio immediately so we can ensure the safety and comfort of your child. Students are not allowed to leave the building without a parent or guardian

COMMUNICATION

Our primary means of communication is via email. Please ensure you have provided the studio with an up-to-date email address that is regularly checked. In case of emergency please make sure the mobile phone number and emergency contact you have provided to the studio is correct and up-to-date.

QUERIES & FEEDBACK

Any concerns or inquiries should be directed to reception. Please note that parents and students cannot directly contact ENCORE teachers through phone, email, social networking, or in person with studio issues unless the principal is consulted first. You are welcome to arrange a meeting with the studio principal via reception.

CAR PARK RULES

We have a small number of onsite carparks available for use at all times. These are clearly sign posted. Please do not park in the carparks of neighbouring businesses at anytime (including weekends & after-hours). Our site is a pedestrian/car shared site and you must drive a maximum of 10kmph. Please always look for children when driving. You must not use the driveway in front of our building to drop off/pick up. This is a no standing zone at all times as it's an active driveway. Safety is our top priority please drive safely and slowly. Do not leave children unattended in car or carpark.
